Located on a beautiful forty-acre campus in the Yakima Valley, La Salle is an independent Catholic high school sponsored by the De La Salle Christian Brothers. Since its opening in 1998, La Salle has proudly formed youth in an educational tradition grounded in the Lasallian Core Principles of Respect for All Persons, Faith in the Presence of God, Inclusive Community, Quality Education and Concern for the Poor and Social Justice.

La Salle is a Catholic, college preparatory high school where students are loved and educated by teachers who are inspired by the charism of Saint John Baptist de La Salle and the Brothers of the Christian Schools. La Salle High School educates students spiritually, academically, and socially through the promotion of an active faith life and commitment to curricular and co-curricular excellence and pushes them toward further learning comparable to their gifts and potential. These goals are accomplished through the collaboration of involved students, supportive parents, and dedicated faculty and staff members. Based on the belief in the intrinsic value and dignity of each student, the school provides an atmosphere that is moral, caring and joyful.
