DECREE

**CONCERNING ST. PATRICK PARISH, HARTLINE,
WASHINGTON BEING RELAGATED TO SECULAR USE**

St. Patrick Catholic Church, Hartline, Washington was closed for public worship in November 2017, and oversight of Holy Angels Catholic Church as a “quasi-parish” was transferred to St. Henry’s Parish in Grand Coulee, Washington at that same time according to Canon 516 of the Code of Canon Law. St. Patrick Catholic Church is no longer needed for sacramental celebrations for the parishioners of Hartline. It is apparent that St. Patrick Catholic Church in Hartline has no longer the purpose for which it was established.

Now in accordance with the provisions of Canon 1224 §2 of the Code of Canon Law and after hearing from the pastor and people of Hartline. Being advised by the Board of Consultors for the Diocese of Yakima, I hereby close St. Patrick Catholic Church in Hartline, Washington.

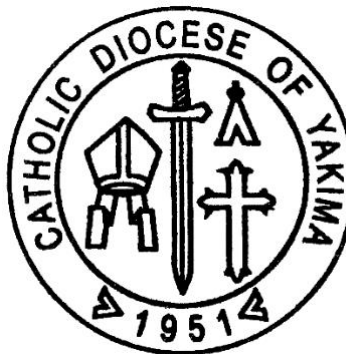
With this decree I declare that St. Patrick Catholic Church be relegated to a place that can be used for secular and profane use but not sordid use in accord with the norms of law effective 12:01 a.m. on May 18, 2021.

Since the oversight of Holy Angels Catholic Church in Coulee City, Washington was transferred to St. Henry’s Parish, Grand Coulee in November 2017, we decree that this transfer of oversight remain in effect in accordance with Canon 516.
